


WHO LIVES HERE?

- · It was founded in 1861.
- You can see more than 70,000 works of art within its two buildings.
- The Great Hall in the museum boasts the world's largest stained glass ceiling, and visitors can enjoy it by lying on the floor!

Eureka Tower

- · The third tallest building in Australia.
- The 88th floor features the highest observation deck in the world's Southern hemisphere.
- Includes a glass cube called "The Edge," that extends from the building allowing super brave visitors to look straight down to the ground!
- Gold-plated windows cover the building's top 10 floors, making sure it truly gleams in the sun.

FUN FACTS:

- Melbourne was originally called Batmania!
 Not for the superhero, but for John Batman who founded the city in 1835.
- Melbourne is known as the coffee capital of Australia, because it has so many cafes.







- A colony of wild penguins lives in Melbourne the St. Kilda Pier offers an up close view of the little birds, especially just after sunset.
- Melbournians love to eat Vegemite, a salty spread made from brewer's yeast.










FLAG FACT:
