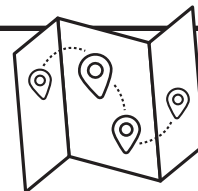

New York City is in New York state, on the East Coast of the United States. It sits between the Atlantic Ocean and the Hudson River.

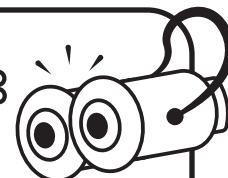
DID YOU KNOW?

PLACES TO SEE:



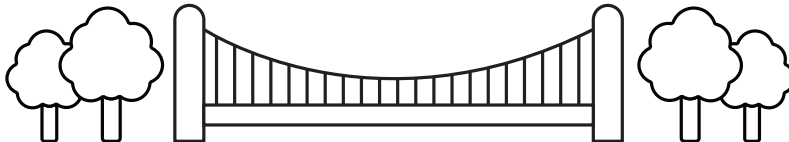
Empire State Building

- One of New York City's most iconic landmarks.
- The 6th tallest building in the U.S.A.
- Has 102 floors and 73 elevators.
- Takes 1,872 steps to get to the top.
- It's so big, it has its own zip code!
- Lights up at night, with different colors to celebrate different holidays and occasions.
- Just a short walk away from one of our largest Toys"R"Us stores in NYC at Macy's Herald Square!

Statue of Liberty

- This copper statue was a gift from France.
- The 7 spikes of the statue's crown represent the world's 7 seas and 7 continents, a symbol of liberty for all.
- Arrived to the United States in pieces, and it took 4 months to assemble.

- New York City has more than 1,600 pizzerias, including Lombardi's, the first pizzeria ever opened in the United States, which you can still visit today.
- There are more than 200 languages spoken in New York City every day.

- There are 789 bridges and tunnels in New York City.
- Central Park in Manhattan is one of the biggest parks in the United States—about the size of 605 American football fields!

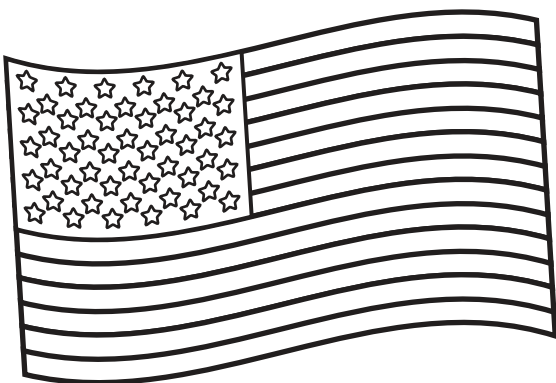

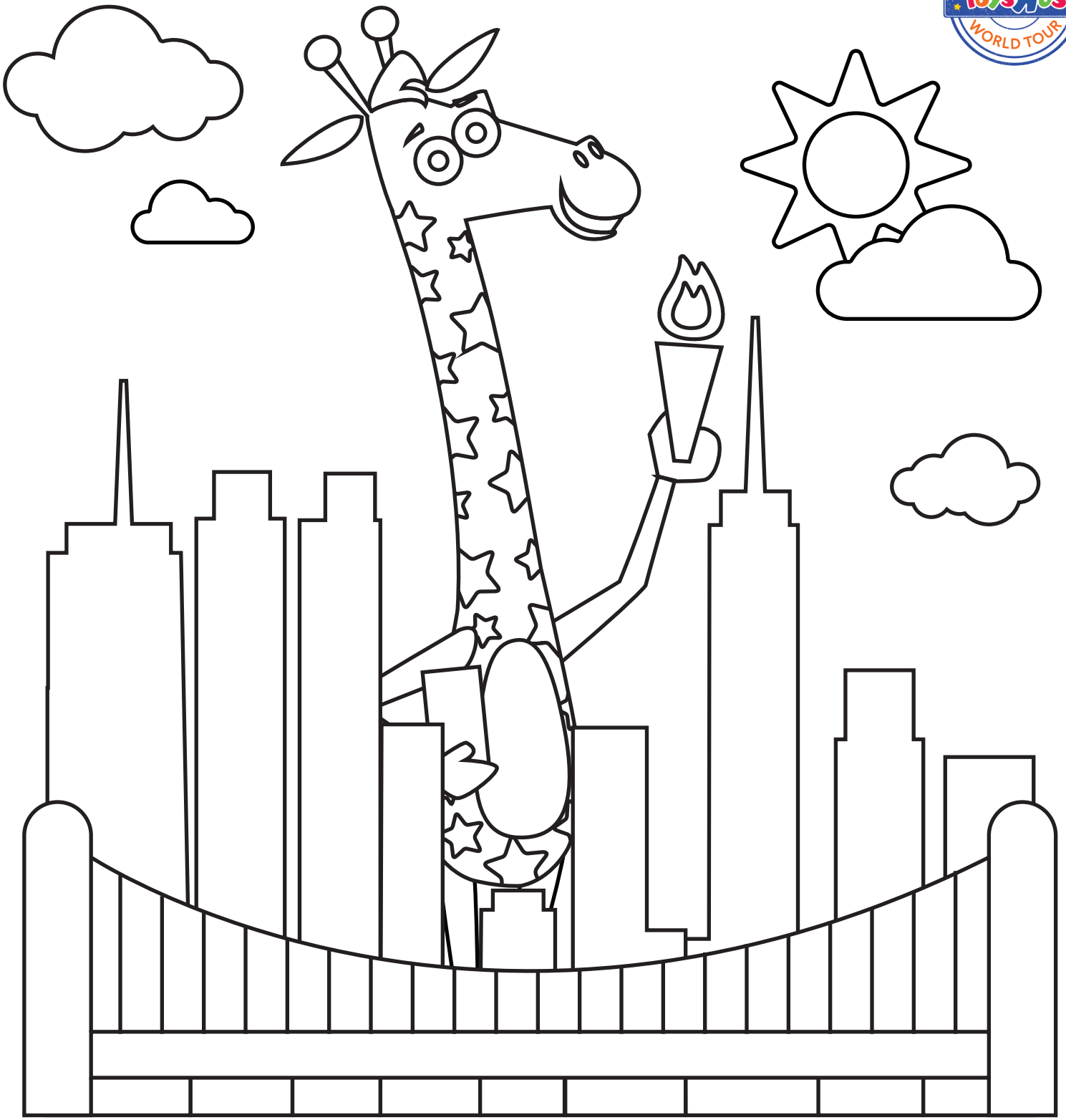
